









Lily pond, 1926



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


US Inaugurals, 1789-2009: %rate of 'god'.

US Inaugurals, 1789-2009: %rate of 'which'.




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






QE2 Xmas broadcasts : o=husband, x=philip.



Agatha chapters: rate of 'or'.


Iris chapters: rate of 'or'.

Text-scoring procedure: basic idea


- Emphasize feature finding:
 - home-brew tokenizer, allows punctuation
 - still single-term based
 - select list of positive and negative markers
 - Association with y-value (e.g. year of composition)
- Use simple predictive formula:
 - Docscore = (P N) / (P + N)
 - $P = \sum f(p_i) + 1$
 - N = $\sum f(n_i) + 1$
- Rationale:

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- Dawes (1979); Gigerenzer & Goldstein (1996); Forsyth (1999); Tetlock et al. (2007)
- avoids "double" cross-validation


Agatha & Iris: something in common?

Agatha predicted by Iris model (r=0.54)




Xmas broadcasts: odd predicted by even

QE2 Xmas broadcasts (even->odd, keymode 2, r=0.8).




Dates of Yeats: holdout sample

In conclusion

- No conclusions yet!
- Hints:

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- Many small effects, no single feature
- Individual authors can be dated (approximately) but not all with the same indicators
- "blurry" depictions (Monet) => "vague" descriptions (Agatha, Iris)?

A long way to go

- Still to do:
 - Corpus compilation
 - Optima data
 - Cookie theft transcription
 - Appeal for donors!
 - Corpus "cleaning"
 - Exploring a range of indicators
 - Term rates
 - Diversity indices
 - Collocations & colligations
 - Etc.
